

# HOW TO ASK FOR DONATIONS

### Follow these tips:

We know that asking for donations can be one of the most daunting parts of fundraising, but it doesn't have to be.

#### Explain why you are fundraising

- "I am fundraising because....."
- "This cause is really important to me because......"
- "I am passionate about social justice because......"

#### Explain how their donation helps your cause

"Your donation could provide breakfast and lunch for the next month to \_\_\_ people experiencing homelessness."

"Your donation could provide someone with crucial and immediate help, which starts with a meal." "Your donation could help fund for a support

worker to build a trusting relationship with someone experiencing homelessness."

"Your donation could help a woman seeking help to access crisis accommodation."

"Your donation can help keep Sacred Heart Mission's Women's House open for women who have nowhere else to turn."

"Your donation helps keep the doors of Sacred Heart Mission's Dining Hall open."

#### Make it easy for them to donate

- Encourage them to scan your QR code
- Share your fundraising page
- If they give you cash let them know you will donate on their behalf.
